**LOCAL RULES**

- OUT OF BOUNDS**  
The River Gala, all boundary fences, walls, clubhouse, car park enclosures and lines defined by white posts to the left whilst playing the 11th hole, right whilst playing the 14th and 16th fairways and extreme left whilst playing the 18th hole. Note that whilst playing the 17th hole the white posts that define the 16th out of bounds do not apply.
- SPRINKLER HEADS**  
All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under rule 24-2. If a ball lies through the green the ball may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, within one club length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief; which must not be on a putting green or hazard.
- INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE**  
Caddy car and pump sheds. Relief only under penalty according to rule 28.
- GROUND UNDER REPAIR**  
(a) Areas marked as GUR enclosed by white lines or (b) Ruts made by vehicle tyres. If a players ball lies in such an area or it interferes with the players normal stance or intended swing the player may take relief under rule 25-1.
- STONES IN BUNKERS**  
Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1).
- OPEN / FRENCH DRAINS / WELL ON THE 17th & ARTIFICIAL SURFACES**  
These are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under rule 24-2.
- PRACTICE GROUND**  
Available on day of medal competitions and defined as any part of the course except hazards or putting green of any hole.
- TEMPORARY/LOCAL RULES**  
Other temporary local rules will be in force if posted clubhouse notice boards.
- HEALTH & SAFETY**  
Extreme care must be exercised when playing tee/approach shots on all holes owing to their proximity to adjacent holes. Take care of approaching vehicles and Trains whilst playing the 3rd & 14th holes respectively.
- AERATION HOLES**  
Relief without penalty may be obtained by moving a ball out of an aeration hole no nearer the hole that avoids the situation.
- MEASUREMENT DEVICES**  
These are permitted in all club competitions.
