Gents Midweek stroke and order of merit competitions will be held every Tuesday from April to September inclusive.

Winter Competitions will be held each weekend between November and March inclusive weather permitting unless other competitions are scheduled.

Gents Club Championships

- Handicap Classes :- A = (under 6), B = (6 to 10), C = (11 to 15), D = (over 15)
- Qualification will be based on the handicap of the player in the 1st Qualifying Competition.
- Qualification will be based on the best two from 3 scores in the Championship Qualifiers.
- Players will be seeded on the lowest aggregate of 2 scores.
- In the event of a tie the player with the best 3rd score will be placed highest
- If neither player has a 3rd score it will be the best score in the 3rd qualifier
- The players with the Top 16 scores who are available will play in the Club Championship irrespective of their starting handicap class.
- Any player whose scores are good enough to qualify in a lower handicap class must compete in the lower class)
- There will be a fully seeded draw in each class with a maximum of 16 players in each class qualifying to play in the Matchplay during Championship week.
